UNIQUE ARCHITECTURE BY WILMOTTE 8 ASSOCIÉS

In 2017, Paris Saint-Germain entrusted the design and construction of its training centre to Wilmotte & Associés architects, who have worked on several prestigious projects.

Wilmotte & Associés designed the Campus Paris Saint-Germain to be like a park, both very private and open to the outside, where the players train, hone their skills and shine, while developing their qualities as people. With an understated and elegant design, the Campus's architecture has a functional layout and is very spacious, to encourage transversality and interaction between the different teams. Plants feature heavily on the site, and ensuring that the centre blends into the landscape was a major aspect of the centre's overall design.

"For the young athletes in the Youth Academy and Pre-Academy, playing alongside professionals players is an enriching and stimulating source of inspiration. Designed on several plateaux, the training centre physically embodies the idea of a career path in football. Perched at the apex of the site, the building dedicated to the professional footballers is a strong architectural marker, symbolising the ultimate goal of every young athlete."



MEN'S TEAM

Looking out over the whole site, the emblematic building designed for the professional footballers offers views of the whole training centre. Elegant and functional, it blends harmoniously into its surroundings, offering the team an exceptional landscaped setting.

The building's increasingly protruding series of overhangs and glazed façades evoke vibration and movement, expressing the idea of the perpetual quest for performance and excellence. A considerable asset in this project, the single bedrooms enable the athletes to prepare and recover in optimum conditions, the day before matches or during training.





2 OUESTIONS FOR MAROUINHOS, CAPTAIN OF THE PARIS SAINT-GERMAIN MEN'S TEAM

WHAT DOES THIS EXCEPTIONAL NEW TRAINING CENTRE REPRESENT?

"Being at this new training centre in Poissy every day is a real pleasure for us all. For those who, like me, knew the Camp des Loges, this new campus represents a magnificent change that puts us in the best possible conditions. There's nothing more to ask: we have absolutely everything we need to prepare ourselves in the best possible way. It's a great source of pride to have gone through these two stages and to see the Club progress in this way. This centre provides us with an optimal environment, where every detail has been designed to support our performance, well-being and ambition."

HOW DO YOU THINK THIS ENVIRONMENT WILL IMPACT ON THE TEAM'S PERFORMANCE AND MOTIVATION?

"I'm convinced that this exceptional environment boosts our motivation and performance. The Campus offers modern facilities adapted to our needs as athletes, whether for training, mental preparation or recovery. For example, spaces like my room on site are essential for me, because that's where I can concentrate before matches, a crucial time for any player. The pitches and locker room are also special places where we spend a lot of time together, which strengthens our team spirit. With everything at our disposal, we can really concentrate on what's important: making progress and winning. I also think that this environment will attract more and more young players, particularly those from the Paris region, who will see the campus as a place where they have everything they need to train in the best possible way."

PLENTY OF SPACE TO BOOST PERFORMANCE

The site's functionality and player comfort were the main criteria taken into consideration when designing the plateau that would be used by the professional footballers.

From the layout of the spaces to ensuring the users can move easily between the different areas, everything has been designed to make things easier for the professionals and their staff. Dedicated and adapted facilities will improve the technical team's day-to-day monitoring of the players.

Beyond the improvements in terms of equipment and support, the space dedicated to professionals was also an opportunity to develop the club's R&D.

OPTIMUM TRAINING CONDITIONS

Outdoors, the professionals' plateau has three smart training pitches and a training area for goalkeepers.

Indoors, the guarters reserved for the professionals and the staff include:

- · changing rooms and a common room;
- · a "Performance" area with high-tech fitness rooms, a video analysis room and therapeutic swimming
- · a medical treatment room, to respect the players' privacy;
- · a catering area;
- · single bedrooms where the players can rest the night before matches or recover after training;
- · a special area for the staff.

AN AREA RESERVED FOR THE MEDIA

The professional footballers' quarters also has a space for receiving the media. It has a reception area with TV screens, a 90-seat auditorium, interview rooms and TV studios, plus a workspace looking out onto the professional pitches and a patio overlooking the whole site.

DEVELOPING

Bringing the women's teams to the site is a key step towards achieving the goal of having all the teams together on the Campus. The aim of this ambitious project is to provide players with modern, purpose-built facilities, enabling them to develop their potential in the best possible conditions. Beyond sporting performance, it also symbolises the Club's commitment to making women's football a central pillar of its identity and strategy, reinforcing its role in promoting equality and excellence within the sporting community.





AN AMBITIOUS VISION AND A PRIORITY FOR PARIS SAINT-GERMAIN

This approach is fully in line with our desire to raise the profile of women's football, both in France and internationally. The Campus Paris Saint-Germain has been designed to meet these ambitions, with in particular the creation of our very first Training Centre dedicated to women's teams. This initiative represents a decisive step in our commitment to developing this section and providing players with an environment that is conducive to their development and performance.

A BUILDING DEDICATED TO WOMEN'S TEAMS: **NEW MOMENTUM FOR WOMEN'S FOOTBALL**

The Campus Paris Saint-Germain continues to expand, as do the Club's ambitions. In the coming months, we will begin construction of a building entirely dedicated to the women's teams, marking a significant step forward for their performance and for equal opportunities for the teams.

The aim of this investment is not only to optimise the performance of the players, but also to ensure that resources are equitable. Modern training facilities with state-of-theart infrastructure, as well as areas for physical preparation, recovery and medical care, have been specially designed to provide athletes with optimum working conditions and resources for their personal development.

The campus has become a meeting place where the teams can get together, help each other and reinforce the family spirit that is the strength of Paris Saint-Germain.

THE YOUTH ACADEMY AND PRE-ACADEMY BROUGHT TOGETHER

Currently with around 140 players, the quarters will include outdoor training facilities and three main buildings:

- The Academy dedicated to sports training includes training and recovery rooms, a medical area, administrative offices and meeting rooms;
- The Education reserved for schooling has classrooms, a computer room, a laboratory, a documentation and information centre, a teachers' lounge, living quarters, a sick bay, etc.
- The Residence is for accommodation.

PERFORMANCE AT THE SERVICE OF YOUNG PEOPLE

The 600m² performance space has new physical training and testing equipment which makes group training easier. The proximity of the balneotherapy area is a real help for the recovery of young athletes.





2 QUESTIONS FOR NOÉMIE FATIER, ACADEMY CENTER PLAYER

 WHAT PERSONAL GOALS DID YOU SET YOURSELF WHEN YOU JOINED THE CENTRE?

"When I joined the academy centre, my first objectives were to get a regular spot in the UI9 team and to win my first cap for the French national team, which I managed to do.

THE EDUCATIONAL CENTRE ON THE CAMPUS PARIS SAINT-GERMAIN The aim of the Cité Éducative is to ensure that all athletes have access to quality education and to promote lifelong learning opportunities.

Paris Saint-Germain offers a wide range of services to make academic success accessible to all:

- Integration of junior high school classes with a unique feature in France: teachers follow pupils from junior high through to the final year of high school, providing personalised support.
- · Creation of a vocational training certificate in retail based around the PSG brand, using a teaching store - the only one of its kind in France - to encourage the practise and application of theoretical teaching.
- · Opening of the first post-baccalaureate sports marketing course to enable young people to graduate with a 2-year degree, fully integrated into the sports schedule.



EXCELLENCE & SUCCESS OFF THE PITCH

The first year of Paris Saint-Germain's Cité Éducative (2023/2024) achieved historic results for the Club, with a record success rate for the baccalauréat school leaver exams.

On the back of such a performance, the Cité Éducative is now a benchmark. These results are perfectly in line with the Club's ambitions in terms of schooling, a pillar of the training Centre's three-pronged project.

COMMITTED

Creating jobs, involving the local residents, supporting initiatives: by choosing to build its training centre in Poissy in Yvelines, Paris Saint-Germain wanted to help boost the local area and strengthen the partnership it has forged with the local authorities ever since the site was selected.

FOR YOUNG PEOPLE: PSG FOR COMMUNITIES

The Campus Paris Saint-Germain provides a new space for PSG For Communities' activities. These include:

- · A Red & Blue School. This is an "after-school" scheme offering a combination of sport and educational activities for children aged 7 to 11 from priority neighbourhoods in Poissy;
- The Allez Les Filles programme introduces young girls aged 11 to 16 from disadvantaged areas in Poissy;
- · Since they have been designed to be easy access, the new Campus infrastructures will make it easier for ill children to visit the site, as part of the partnership between PSG For Communities and the Necker Hospital. This partnership, which has run since 2012, invites ill children to watch training sessions and meet their favourite players.

FOR THE LOCAL AREA

Job creation, support for local initiatives and partnerships with local authorities are all priorities for Paris Saint-Germain. By choosing to locate its training and education centre in Poissy in Yvelines, the Club is making an active contribution to the region's economic vitality, while strengthening the links established during the site selection phase.

In economic terms, more than 100 people work full-time on the Paris Saint-Germain Campus (excluding staff and players in the sports sections). Most of the service providers working at the training centre are local companies - for gardens, catering, etc. - promoting local employment and mobilising local resources.

The results of the latest study carried out by the CDES (Centre for Sports Law and Economics) highlight the strength of Paris Saint-Germain's roots in the region and its contribution to the local economy:

- Paris Saint-Germain has generated a total positive economic impact of €243m over the 2023/2024 season, of which €194.4m is directly attributable to its ambitious investments. such as the Campus Paris Saint-Germain in Poissy.
- In 5 years, the Club's contribution to the wealth created in the Paris Region has increased by 25%.

ADOPTING

The Campus Paris Saint-Germain is located on an exceptional site, close to the Coteaux de la Seine. The new centre is built in such a way that it respects the natural landscape and its biodiversity: less than 10% of the site's surface area is taken up by buildings.

Through the choices made in terms of design, layout and energy and resource management, Paris Saint-Germain has aimed for environmental excellence.

RESPECTING THE SITE'S NATURAL LANDSCAPE

The site is located in a hilly area, in the heart of a remarkable natural landscape with beautiful views. Preserving this unique identity was one of the keys to Wilmotte & Associés' architectural project, and one of the main reasons the club selected their proposal.

Inspired by the natural surroundings and their rural identity, the landscaping of the site by Neveux Rouyer creates visual perspectives and ecological continuity that respect the omnipresent natural backdrop.

PRESERVING AND ENHANCING THE SITE'S BIODIVERSITY

The site and its surrounding area include:

- · a vegetable garden and orchards, the fruit and vegetables from which will be eaten on site by the Club's players and employees;
- fields and grassy areas to recreate the natural habitats required to preserve the species present on the site.

What is more, the project is doing its best to preserve the Forest of Marly, a cherished reservoir of biodiversity located right next to the site, by extending the woodland. The project also includes planting 4,000 trees on the site.

USING LOCAL SUPPLIERS WHERE POSSIBLE

In addition to the fruit and vegetables grown on site, Paris Saint-Germain buys in fresh produce from local producers to promote local food supply channels.

RESPONSIBLE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

The training centre requires significant amounts of water and energy. With the aim of setting an ecological example, the project has been designed in such a way that the buildings' energy performance is optimised, and its water resources are managed in the best way possible. As an example, rainwater is collected and used to water the pitches.

Finally, users will travel between the club's two sites (Parc des Princes and Campus Paris Saint-Germain) in a fleet of electric and/or hybrid vehicles.


3.5 HECTARES DEDICATED TO AN ORGANIC VEGETABLE GARDEN!

The only one of its kind, the new Paris Saint-Germain training centre has more than 30 hectares of gardens and planted areas with multiple functions: vegetable gardens, meadows, woodland and footpaths.

3.5 hectares are dedicated to an organic vegetable garden, growing local fruit and vegetables. There are also pear orchards that were already present on the site, 80% of which have been preserved. The Poissy vegetable garden and orchards are a distinctive feature of this training centre, which is unique in the world due to its size.

INTEGRATING INNOVATION

Here, technology helps optimise the sporting performance and the management of buildings and equipment. This XXL sports campus, located in green surroundings, is 100% connected. As an aggregator and incubator of technological innovation, the Campus Paris Saint-Germain can rely on systems, infrastructure and storage capacity to integrate the best and most efficient solutions and innovations, current and future.



THE CAMPUS PARIS SAINT-GERMAIN: **INNOVATION IN 6 KEY POINTS**

O PERFORMANCE

Data analysis and monitoring are at the heart of sporting performance. For instance, in the cutting-edge technology rooms, IT systems collect important data in order to elaborate specific support and monitoring programs for each player.

@ SECURITY

The protection of sensitive information is paramount for the club. Multiple security measures are implemented for data protection: firewalls, network access control, intrusion detection systems, encryption protocols...

6 CONTINUITY

Ensuring maximum service availability and operational continuity in all circumstances is a key principle of the club's Business Continuity Plan (BCP): if a component or system fails, a backup solution is immediately activated to prevent any disruption.

4 CONNECTIVITY

A high-speed wireless network is available throughout the Training Centre to provide connectivity to players, staff and media. It also has indoor 5G connectivity and solutions for IoT device integration.

9 ENERGY EFFICIENCY

As well as sporting performance, the club's focus is on environmental performance. Particular attention is given to the energy efficiency of the infrastructure and to the reduction of unnecessary energy consumption.

The Club has large storage capabilities with a long-term vision in mind, to be able to integrate new innovative solutions in the future.
